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Quality assessment and quality control

- 12–13 weeks (always coordinated with ERG and with specific partner institution's requirements)
- January–April (8. 2. is a national holiday, students get a day off)

Content

- Academic component (9 ECTs)
 - **Quality control in general radiography – 3 ECTs**
 - Linguistic and cultural diversity awareness in healthcare – 3 ECTs
 - Preventing musculoskeletal problems among health professionals – 3 ECTs
- Clinical placement (11 ECTs, 7 weeks)

Clinical placement

- University medical centre Ljubljana (CT, MRI, OR, ER, trauma)
- Institute of Oncology Ljubljana (CT, MRI, mammography, nuclear medicine)
- 7 weeks at one/two diagnostics, students preferences considered if possible

Possibilities for students

- Travel: on the weekends, they also get a „free“ week at the begining of the exchange (1 week in January)
- Research: possibilities to perform some phantom studies in general x-ray
- Adjustable schedule (afternoon instead of morning, if the student has some other study obligations (i. e. thesis meetings etc.).

Teacher exchange

- Quality assessment and quality control, general radiography, mammography, dental radiography ... Other possibilities available in cooperation with hospitals.
- Best period for exchange: October, November (not exclusively).
- Practical issues: lack of equipment at faculty (more at hospitals).
