To help you settle in, we have put together a few tips about local cafés, restaurants, parks and cultural spots that students often enjoy. Whether you prefer exploring the old town, trying good coffee, or spending time in green areas, Olomouc offers many opportunities to relax and feel at home.

Here are some useful tips and favourite places among students:

## Food

Here's a list of **Olomouc's bistro, patisseries, and experiential restaurants** — places that we, locals, absolutely love <3

Tips - **Lunch menus** (11:00–15:00) are always cheaper — often under 200 CZK. All of these spots are within a 15-min tram ride from the University area.

### 1. Pastryum

**Type:** Artisan bakery & café

**Vibe:** French pastry lab meets minimal coffee shop.

**Specialties:**

- Pistachio croissant, caramel–hazelnut croissant, strawberry Danish.
- Everything is handmade — small batches, butter-based doughs, and seasonal fillings.



**Why it's special:**

They open only a few days a week (Tue, Thu, Fri, Sat) and sell out early. Locals line up before 9 AM.

**Address:** Ztracená, Olomouc

## 2. Claudio Bistro

**Type:** Italian street-food bistro

**Vibe:** Small, friendly, very Italian.

**Specialties:**



- Schiacciata a Tuscan-style flatbread sandwich filled with prosciutto, burrata, mortadella, truffle cream, or roasted veggies.
- Fresh ingredients imported directly from Italy

### Why it's special:

They serve authentic, high-quality Italian food at student-friendly prices — quick lunch but still a gourmet experience.

**Address:** Ztracená, Olomouc

## 3. Konvikt Bistro & Bar

**Type:** Contemporary bistro

**Vibe:** Set inside a 17th-century Jesuit convent mix of modern design & historic charm.

**Specialties:**

- Seasonal dishes with Czech and Mediterranean influences.
- Homemade hummus, grain bowls, soups, and local craft beers.



### Why it's special:

They cook with local ingredients, change the menu monthly, and have great **vegetarian** options.

Perfect for lunch between lectures or casual dinner.

**Address:** Univerzitní 3, Olomouc

## 4. Bistro Paulus

**Type:** Modern casual dining

**Chef:** Roman Paulus – Michelin-starred chef (formerly at Alcron Prague).

**Specialties:**

- “Czech cuisine reimagined”: roasted duck with cabbage variations, fish fillets with lemon risotto, seasonal soups.
- Daily lunch menu that's more **affordable for students.**



**Why it's special:**

It's like fine dining but in a laid-back atmosphere. You can taste Michelin-level food without spending a fortune.

**Address:** tř. Kosmonautů 1221/2a, Olomouc

## 5. Bistro no1

**Type:** Burger bistro / street food

**Vibe:** Cool, fast, and proudly local pure burger energy.

**Specialities:**

- Double Rookie – classic beef, cheddar & pickles.
- Blue Stilton – bold twist with blue cheese & bacon.
- Turkey Burger – lighter, honey-mayo flavor.
- Mega Boy – massive “party burger” for sharing.



**Why go:**

Handmade buns, quality beef, and crazy-good sauces. Quick, fresh, and easily the best street burger in town.

**Address:** Riegrova 29

## 6. La scala

**Type:** Italian trattoria & pizzeria

**Vibe:** Elegant but relaxed — great for a date or nicer dinner.

**Specialties:**

- Wood-fired pizzas, pasta, risotto, Italian desserts.

**Why it's special:**

Chef-trained staff, authentic Italian feel, and great tiramisu.

**Address:** Kateřinská 6, Olomouc



## 7. Pizza hradlo

**Type:** Local favorite pizzeria

**Vibe:** Cozy, friendly, classic Czech–Italian mix.

**Specialties:**

- Thin-crust pizzas baked in a stone oven.
- Prosciutto e funghi, Quattro formaggi, Diavola.

**Why it's special:**

Affordable, authentic pizza — made with proper Italian ingredients.

**Address:** Hradisko 30, Olomouc



## 8. Running sushi Šantovka



**Type:** Conveyor-belt sushi restaurant

**Vibe:** Casual, fun, and perfect for groups.

**Specialties:**

- Fresh sushi, rolls, nigiri, sashimi, and small warm dishes like tempura or gyoza.
- All-you-can-eat conveyor style.

**Why it's special:**

A social experience — sit by the belt and grab what you like.

**Pro tip:** Go during lunch (cheaper buffet price).

**Address:** Galerie Šantovka, Polská 1, Olomouc

## 9. Viet Village



**Type:** Authentic Vietnamese restaurant

**Vibe:** Simple, cozy, and full of locals (always a good sign).

**Specialties:**

- Classic Pho bo / Pho ga, Bun nem, Bun bo Hue, and stir-fried noodles.
- Homemade sauces — their chili-lime fish sauce is amazing.

**Why it's special:**

No fusion here — just real Vietnamese comfort food, generous portions, and fast service.

**Pro tip:** Great lunch stop between classes — meals around 150–200 CZK.

**Address:** 8. května 21, Olomouc

## 10. Ca Phé District

**Type:** Vietnamese café + bistro

**Vibe:** Industrial courtyard café, minimal design, lots of plants

— feels like a modern Saigon coffee house.

**Specialties:**

- Pho bo, bun cha, fresh spring rolls, Vietnamese drip coffee.
- Seasonal specials like iced coconut coffee and bánh mì.



**Why it's special:**

They combine an authentic Vietnamese kitchen with the chill aesthetic of a European café — perfect for brunch or early dinner.

**Address:** Uhelná 11, Olomouc

## 11. Špagetárna

**Type:** Pasta / quick Italian bistro (takeaway + limited seating)

**Vibe:** Cozy, casual, “minute pasta” spot for a fast, good meal

**Specialties:**

- Spaghetti Boloňské, Arrabiata, Spinach, Spaghetti with zucchini & tomato sauce.



They always add **Parmesan** and **fresh arugula** on top (you can ask to omit).

**Why it's special:**

It's a local favorite for quick, tasty pasta made fresh. Great for lunch or dinner when you want something familiar, comforting, and not overly fancy — but still good quality.

**Address:** 1. Máje 825/4, Olomouc

## 12. Simple dumpl

**Type:** Dumpling bar / street-food bistro

**Vibe:** Small, modern, and cozy — handmade dumplings from around the world.

### What to try:

- **Juicy Pork** – pork, cabbage, mushrooms, ginger & soy.
- **Beef & Cheddar** – beef, caramelized onion, BBQ sauce, melted cheddar.
- **Veggie Dumplinks** – spinach, ricotta, or mushroom fillings

### Why go:

Freshly made dumplings with creative fillings. Fast service, good prices.

## 13. Long story short

**Type:** Modern bistro & fine dining

**Vibe:** Minimalist, stylish, set in a renovated historical fortress

### Try:

- Seasonal tasting menu (modern European / Czech fusion)
- Homemade sourdough bread & pastries from their bakery



### Why go:

Chef-driven, design-forward restaurant with outstanding food and service — easily one of Olomouc's *signature dining spots*. Perfect for brunch, dinner, or a special night out.

Here are some cafés, dessert spots, and bars in Olomouc.

## 1. Kafe Pikola

**Type:** Espresso bar / café

**Vibe:** Cozy, local, ideal for coffee lovers

**What to try:**

- Specialty espresso, flat white, filter coffee, homemade cakes and desserts



**Why it's special:** They use locally roasted beans, have friendly atmosphere and nice garden

**Address:** Sokolská 586/7, Olomouc

## 2. NM Desserts

**Type:** Dessert / pastry shop

**Vibe:** Elegant, dessert-centric, Instagram-friendly

**What to try:**

- High-end cakes, pastries, creative dessert plate



**Why it's special:** Fine craftsmanship — every dessert is like a mini work of art; original & artisan cakes on world level”

**Address:** Třída Míru 260/32, Olomouc

## 3. Cafe La Féé & Coffee Library

These are among the top rated dessert / café spots in Olomouc (according to reviews)

- **La Féé** — charming café & tea spot, ideal for desserts and relaxed afternoon breaks.
- **Coffee Library** — cozy, quiet spot good for studying + good coffees and cakes.



## 4. Kafec - Vila Primavesi

**Type:** Café & brunch spot in an Art Nouveau villa

**Vibe:** Elegant, bright, with garden views  
one of Olomouc's prettiest cafés.



**Try:**

- Signature **Belgian waffles** (sweet or savory). **Specialty coffee** and homemade cakes
- **Toasts & scrambled eggs** with mascarpone,

**Why go:** Top brunch in town — great food, perfect coffee, and a stunning location inside historic

**Address:** Univerzitní 7, Olomouc

## 5. Zmrzlinárium Café Centro

**Type:** Artisan gelato café

**Vibe:** Bright, stylish, always buzzing — a local classic for ice cream lovers.

**Try:**

- Pistachio, salted caramel, mango, cheesecake
- Seasonal fruit sorbets



**Why go:**

Olomouc's most famous gelato spot — fresh daily, natural ingredients, and creative flavors that change every week.

**Address:** Na Střelnici 37, Olomouc

# BARS

## 6. Vertigo

**Type:** Student club / bar

**Vibe:** Energetic, party nights, student crowd

**What to expect:**

- DJ nights, drinks, lively dancefloor

**Why it's special:** One of the go-to night spots for students.

long nights, good crowd, dynamic music

**Address:** Univerzitní 6, Olomouc



## 7. Say Yes Bar

**Type:** Cocktail bar / lounge

**Vibe:** Intimate, stylish, good for evening drinks and social nights

**What to try:**

- Signature cocktails (creative mixes, seasonal ingredients)
- Classic favorites (Old Fashioned, Mojito, etc.)
- Great selection of spirits and beers



**Why it's special:**

Cozy bar with a stylish setting — perfect for relaxed evenings or meeting friends. It's not a full dance club, but a place where atmosphere and drinks are the stars. **ISIC 10% discounts**

**Address:** třída 1. Máje 32, Olomouc

## 8. Bar Zahrada

**Type:** Garden bar / outdoor bar + grill & smokehouse

**Vibe:** Chill, relaxed, “hidden gem” garden atmosphere

**What to try:**

- Craft beers (from microbreweries + big names)
- Mixes & cocktails, smoked dishes, burgers, grill / barbecue items
- Cold drinks, local beers — a good selection



**Why it's special:**

It's a cozy open-air bar tucked behind a wall with live music Nights, relaxed vibe, friendly staff, garden seating

**Address:** Mlýnská 79, Olomouc

## 9. Axiom Pub

**Type:** Craft beer pub

**Vibe:** Modern, lively, local favorite for beer lovers.



**Try:**

- Up to **17 rotating taps** from *Axiom Brewery* & guest microbreweries, IPAs, stouts, sours, and seasonal specials
- Light snacks to pair with beer

**Why go:**

Top spot for Czech craft beer — friendly staff, cozy interior, and new brews every week.

**Address:** Panská 4, Olomouc

## 10. Na břehu Rhôny

**Type:** French-style wine bar & bistro

**Vibe:** Elegant yet relaxed — dim lights, jazz, and the clink of wine glasses. Feels like a cozy **Try:**

- Self-serve system: pour your own wine from over 20 open bottles (mostly French)
- Rhône Valley specialties – Syrah, Grenache, Côtes du Rhône blends
- Cheese & charcuterie boards, pâté, and fresh baguettes

**Why go:**

A true wine lover's paradise — you can taste at your own pace, from a few sips to a full glass.

**Address:** Dolní náměstí 2, Olomouc

Here are some **historic, botanical & scenic spots** in and around Olomouc worth visiting

## 1. Olomouc Castle & Wenceslas Hill

Medieval castle complex with the **Archbishop's Palace** and **St. Wenceslas Cathedral**.

**Why visit:** It's the historic heart of the city, offering both architecture and peaceful views over the old town.

Gothic cathedral dating back to the 12th century with a 100 m tower — one of the tallest in the country.

**Why visit:** Climb the tower for a panoramic view and see the ornate interior and ancient crypts.



## 2. Church of St. Maurice - St. Maurice Tower

Late Gothic church near the Upper Square.

**Why visit:** You can climb its tower — one of the best city viewpoints — and listen to concerts played on its historic organ.

Gothic bell tower accessible to visitors.

**Why visit:** The best 360° view of Olomouc's rooftops and both squares.



### 3. Church of St. Michael

Baroque gem with three domes, frescoes, and calm atmosphere.

**Why visit:** A peaceful interior and excellent example of Czech Baroque architecture just minutes from the main square.



### 4. Hradisko Monastery

Former Benedictine / Premonstratensian monastery, now a military hospital.

**Why visit:** Massive Baroque architecture and one of the most impressive monastic complexes in Moravia



### 5. Flora Olomouc Botanical Garden & Rosarium

Large park complex with greenhouses, themed gardens, and a rose collection.

**Why visit:** Perfect for a quiet walk or a picnic; the spring and summer flower exhibitions are beautiful.



## 6. Bezručovy Sady Park, Smetanovy Sady

Bezručovy - A long green belt under the old city walls, full of walking paths and flowers.

**Why visit:** Great place to relax, jog, or enjoy nature while staying close to the historic center.

Smetanovy - Grand park with tree alleys, fountains, and the Flora exhibition center.

**Why visit:** Lovely for afternoon walks, picnics, or a peaceful break — especially in spring bloom



## 7. Botanical Greenhouses (Flora Pavilion A & B)

Part of the Flora exhibition grounds.

**Why visit:** Tropical plants, succulents, orchids, and butterflies — great for photos and rainy days.



## 8. Archdiocesan Museum

**Why visit:** One of the most important museums in Moravia — beautiful interiors, religious art, Gothic and Baroque sculptures, and an ancient palace. The courtyard garden is peaceful and free to enter.



## 9. Fort Science – Interactive Science Center

Part of Palacký University, located in a former artillery fort.

**Why visit:** Interactive exhibits for physics, biology, astronomy, and robotics. Perfect for students - you can touch, test, and play with everything.



## 10. The Olomouc Astronomical Clock

Located on the Town Hall tower in the Upper Square.

**Why visit:** Unique socialist-realist design from the 1950s — one of only two astronomical clocks of its kind in the world still operating. The figures move every day at noon.



Here's list of **top trips around Olomouc** + with how to get there

## 1. Bouzov Castle

**Why visit:** A fairytale castle — one of the most beautiful in the Czech Republic, often used in films. Tower climb and guided tours available.

**Getting there by public transport:** From Olomouc main bus station take a bus toward Loštice or Bouzov - usually **line 890343** or **890342**



## 2. Šternberk Castle

**Why visit:** Gothic-Renaissance castle with guided tours, exhibits, and beautiful town views.

**Getting there by public transport:**

Train from Olomouc hlavní nádraží → Šternberk (ČD regional line, departs roughly every 30–60 min).



### 3. Náměšť na Hané Château

**Why visit:** Elegant Baroque château with beautiful park and richly decorated halls.

**Getting there by public transport:**

From Olomouc bus station take bus **890344** to *Náměšť na Hané, zámek*.



### 4. Čechy pod Kosířem Château

**Why visit:** Romantic château in an English-style park, connected to painter Josef Mánes.

**Getting there by public transport:**

Take bus **890331** from *Olomouc* → *Lutín* → *Čechy pod Kosířem*.



### 5. Velký Kosíř Hill & Lookout Tower

**Why visit:** Gentle “Haná Mountain” with a wooden lookout tower and open countryside views.

**Getting there by public transport:**

Bus **890331** (same as for Čechy pod Kosířem Château).



## 6. Svatý Kopeček / Olomouc Zoo

**Why visit:** Stunning Baroque basilica with panoramic city views; nearby forest zoo with lookout tower.

**Getting there by public transport:**

**City bus no. 11** from *Náměstí Hrdinů* → final stop *Svatý Kopeček – bazilika*.



## 7. Litovelské Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area

**Why visit:** Lush forests and rivers — ideal for cycling, hiking, or canoeing.

**Getting there by public transport:**

Train Olomouc → Horka nad Moravou (ČD regional line).



## 8. Plumlov Château

**Why visit:** A striking and unusual Renaissance-Baroque château built high on a rock above a lake. Known for its *narrow, tall shape* and scenic views. Offers guided tours, concerts, and open-air events in summer.

**Getting there by public transport:**

From Olomouc main bus station take **bus 890331** or **890332** toward *Prostějov* → *Plumlov*.

## 1. Eurogym (near FNOL)


**Type:** Fitness & gym center

**Type:** Hot yoga & pilates studio

### 3. Ultimate Fitness Olomouc

**Type:** CrossFit & strength training gym

**Type:** Indoor climbing gym

**Vibe:** Modern bouldering hall with chill zone & café.

### 5. Koruna Gym (Club Koruna) / SMASH GYM

**Type:** Martial arts & group fitness center

**Vibe:** Community-based, energetic, family-friendly.

**Try:** Kickboxing, karate, self-defense, Cross training

## 6. Sokol Olomouc / Muay Thai

**Type:** Traditional sports center

**Vibe:** Classic Czech gym with a mix of martial arts, gymnastics, and fitness.

**Try:** Boxing, judo, general fitness. Affordable, inclusive, and historic — perfect for students looking for regular sports activities.



## 7. Extra: Outdoor & Casual Fitness

**Bezručovy sady & Smetanova sady** — running paths, outdoor fitness stations, and open green areas for yoga or stretching.

**Náplavka by the river** — popular for jogging, roller skating, or outdoor workouts in summer.
