

GENERAL INFORMATION / ENROLMENT PROCEDURES

ERASMUS RADIOGRAPHY STUDENTS

The following is a list of all the requirements needed for you to be registered as a radiography ERASMUS student in Malta:

1. Nomination e-mail

Students are to verify that there is a Bilateral Agreement between their home institution and the Department of Radiography at the University of Malta. Once this is confirmed, it is important that the home institution coordinator sends an official e-mail in English to nominate the student/s for the Erasmus+ programme.

2. University of Malta Registration Form

3. Copy of Immunization record

This must include evidence of immunity to Hepatitis B or absence of markers of infectivity

4. Registration of Radiography Study Units Form

5. 'Learning Agreement'

This must reflect the study units to be performed in Malta and must be signed by the student and sending institution

6. Copy of student's passport / ID Card

7. Copy of student's European Health insurance Card

8. Four (4) passport size photos

9. Copy of Online Linguistic Support (OLS) test

The English level should be included in the 'Language competence of the student' section in the ERASMUS+ learning agreement. Students need to have a B2 level in English and no concessions will be made to students whose level of English is lower than expected.

10. Copy of student's travel insurance for the complete period of the exchange

Students are encouraged to have a Travel Insurance that includes items which are not covered by the EHIC such as: personal belongings, health services, evacuation and repatriation. The International & EU Office recommends that all students should ensure that they have an appropriate insurance cover for the full period of their mobility in Malta.

11. Copy of student's Professional indemnity cover

Students **MUST** have professional indemnity cover for the entire period of the ERASMUS+ programme to be performed in Malta. If unavailable from home institution, this can be offered by the UoM upon request.

12. Certificate of Police Conduct

In line with Regulation 81 (Paragraph 2) of the General Regulations for University Undergraduate Awards, 2004, students registered with the Faculty of Health Sciences are requested to present a certificate of Police Conduct issued by their local authorities. The certificate should be recent (issued within the last one month) and is to be submitted with the enrolment documents. This document is a requirement for admission.

No particular concessions are allowed to students whose level of English is lower than expected.

Students' acceptance is conditional to the acceptance from the European Unit and is also conditional to the receipt of all the required forms/documents in original format.

Students are requested to stay in Malta for three calendar months; they must sit for all their tests and hand in all assignments before leaving.
